Parent of the Day (POD)

The Parent of the Day Program is an essential part of junior sailing. The program provides first aid services, general assistance for the director and coaches, and monitor's VHF radio for program and weather emergencies.

A parent or guardian should volunteer at least once during the program for their child. A schedule is maintained, so no one is overburdened.

POD Schedule:

1. Contact the director once you arrive on site.
2. You will receive a brief orientation and be assigned the junior sailing first aid bag. Keep the bag with you at all times.
3. Take your position at the VHF monitoring desk, where you can be easily located if needed.
4. During the day you might be asked to:
 - administer Band-Aids; attend to sea nettle stings and maintain the medical log
 - help the director make phone calls and complete odd jobs
 - generally help monitor and supervise the sailors during lunch
5. From noon to 12:30 pm, you will assist in supervising lunch. After the buffet line closes down at 12:30 pm, we would appreciate your help supervising and playing with the children until class starts again at 1 pm. There will be other instructors on duty. At 1 pm, please collect the play equipment and return it to the junior sailing room.
6. At the end of the day, please report any problems, concerns, and any restocking first aid needs to the director, and help the coaches supervise the children in general clean up and check out.
